**(1) Introduction to DOT & FMCSA Audits** – A brief overview of the administration. The participants will learn about compliance review audits, safety measurement scores, company safety ratings, and the DataQ and Crash Preventability Programs.

**(2) Applicability of DOT Regulations** – The participants will learn when a driver is subject to the regulations in interstate commerce and discuss Texas Intrastate applicability and exemptions to the regulations.

**(3) Driver Qualification** – The participants will learn about basic the requirements and processes for hiring qualified drivers and how to correctly build driver qualification files.

**(4) DOT Drug & Alcohol / Clearinghouse** – The participants will learn about drug and alcohol testing requirements and using the Clearinghouse database system.

**(5) Hours of Service / Electronic Logging Device** – The participants will learn about basic hours of service rules for interstate and intrastate drivers along with the rules and requirements governing the use of electronic logs.

**(6) Inspection, Repair, and Maintenance** – The participants will learn the criteria required for a company's vehicle maintenance program and the required documentation for vehicle files.
