



What is the DOT Compliance Training Program (DCTP)?

The DOT Compliance Training Program (DCTP) is a year-round training program designed for professionals responsible for DOT compliance and commercial motor vehicle operations. Instead of registering and paying separately for individual training courses, DCTP Program Members receive access to scheduled training courses, on-demand training, professional resources, and instructor support throughout their active membership year.

How much does DCTP cost?

DCTP enrollment is \$1,450 for one year of access. Your membership begins on the date you enroll and remains active for 12 months.

What training courses are included?

Program Members may attend scheduled DCTP training courses offered during their active membership period.

Courses include:

- DOT Compliance Manager
- Commercial Vehicle & Brake Inspector
- DOT Hazardous Materials Transportation
- DOT Roadside Inspection - Equipment
- DOT Audit & Compliance Review
- Motor Carrier Crash Response & Investigation
- Additional courses, workshops, and regulatory update sessions

Course offerings vary throughout the year. Members should refer to the current DCTP Training Calendar for scheduled dates, locations, and course availability.

Can I attend more than one course?

Yes. That's one of the primary benefits of DCTP. During your active membership, you may attend multiple scheduled DCTP training courses rather than purchasing each course individually. You may also repeat a course when it is offered again during your active membership.

Is DOT Roadside Ready included with DCTP?

Yes. Active DCTP Program Members receive access to the DOT Roadside Ready on-demand content platform at no additional cost during their active membership. DOT Roadside Ready provides additional self-paced DOT compliance training that members can watch anytime. It is normally available as a separate \$30/month subscription, representing a \$360 annual value included with DCTP membership.

Can I access DCTP from my phone?

Yes. DCTP is powered through Kajabi and is mobile accessible. Members can access available course content, DOT Roadside Ready videos, training resources, community features, and other program content from compatible mobile devices. Whether you're at the office, traveling, in the field, or simply have a few minutes available, DCTP gives you the ability to learn and review information on the go. Search for Kajabi on the Apple App Store or Google Play and log in with the same credentials you use for DCTP.

Are courses available in person?

Yes. DCTP includes access to scheduled in-person training courses. Courses are offered at selected training locations, with additional locations added as the program expands. Dates and locations are published on the DCTP Training Calendar. Because classroom seating may be limited, advance registration or seat reservation may be required.

What if I can't travel to an in-person course?

DCTP also includes virtual training opportunities. Select courses may be presented live online, and additional online training, workshops, and regulatory updates may be scheduled throughout the year. Combined with DOT Roadside Ready and other on-demand resources, members have multiple ways to continue learning even when attending an in-person course isn't practical.

Are the in-person and virtual courses different?

The method of delivery may be different, but DCTP is designed to provide members with access to professional DOT compliance training whether they participate in person or online. Certain courses or activities involving hands-on instruction may only be available in person.

Are course dates guaranteed?

DCTP maintains a published training calendar so members can plan ahead. Course dates, topics, locations, and delivery methods may occasionally change due to scheduling, facility availability, enrollment, instructor availability, or other circumstances. New training opportunities may also be added throughout the year.

Do I have to pay additional tuition when I attend a DCTP course?

No. Active DCTP Program Members do not pay additional course tuition for eligible scheduled DCTP training courses during their active membership. Travel, lodging, meals, printing, and other personal expenses associated with attending an in-person course are the responsibility of the member.

Are student manuals provided?

Course manuals and applicable training materials are provided digitally through DCTP. Members may download and print the student manual before attending training. Members attending an in-person course are responsible for printing any materials they want to use during class.

Will I receive additional reference materials and handouts?

Applicable handouts, quick-reference guides, checklists, and other DCTP resources may be made available digitally through the member portal. These resources can be downloaded and printed for the member's individual professional use.

Can I share my course materials with coworkers?

DCTP training materials and resources are provided for the individual member's use. Materials may not be reproduced, redistributed, resold, uploaded, used to conduct third-party training, or otherwise distributed without authorization from Safety Compliance & Training LLC.

Can I ask questions after a course is over?

Yes. Compliance questions often arise after training, when you return to work and begin applying what you learned. Active Program Members have access to direct instructor messaging through the DCTP community, allowing them to ask questions and seek additional clarification throughout their membership year. Your access doesn't end when the class does.

Are course recordings available?

Recordings of applicable online training and selected training sessions may be made available through the DCTP member portal. Availability may vary depending on the course or training format.

Is DCTP a monthly membership?

No. DCTP is an annual program. Enrollment provides 12 months of access beginning on your enrollment date.

Can my employer pay for my DCTP enrollment?

Yes. Employers may purchase DCTP enrollment for employees as part of their professional training and development. Each DCTP enrollment provides one individual with their own 12 months of program access.

What happens when my 12 months are over?

You may renew your DCTP membership for another year to maintain access to scheduled training, DOT Roadside Ready, resources, the member community, direct instructor messaging, and other active-member benefits.
